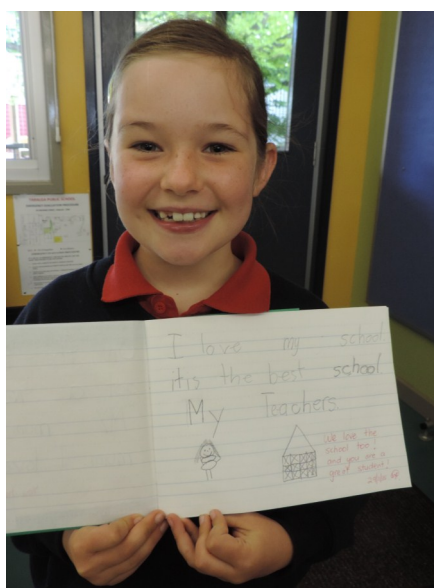
Welcome back to Mrs Marshall, it's great to see you back.

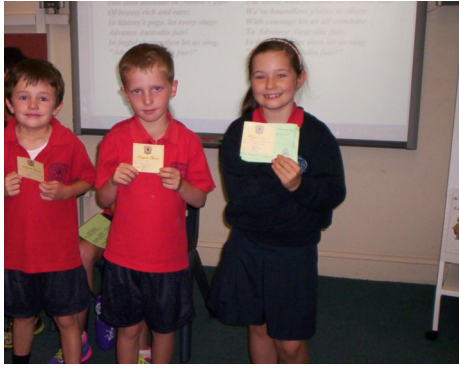

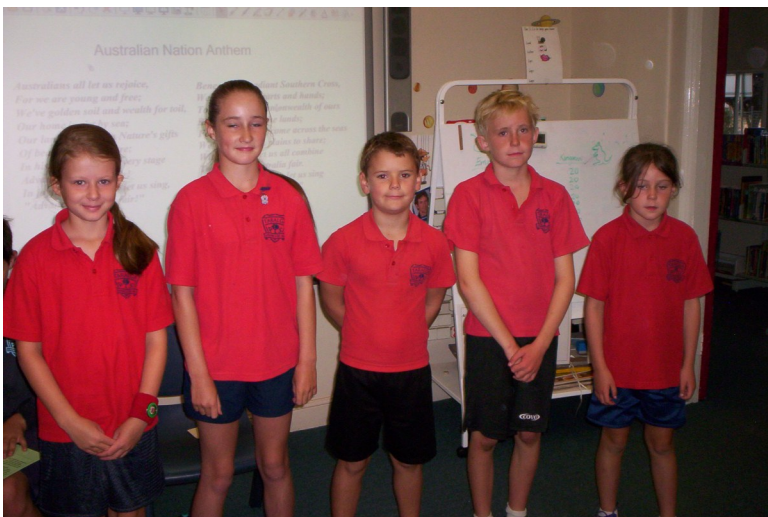
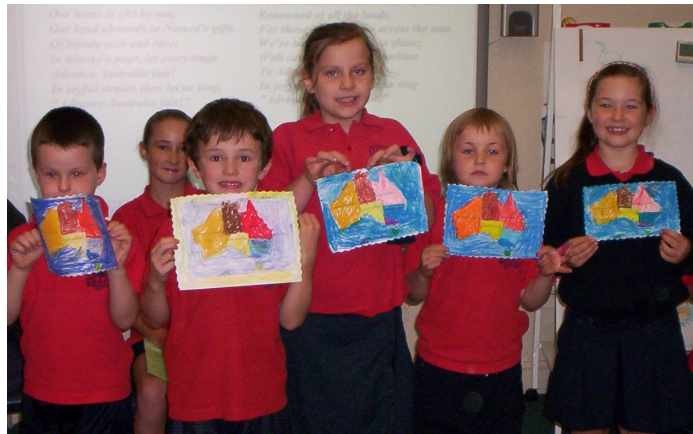
