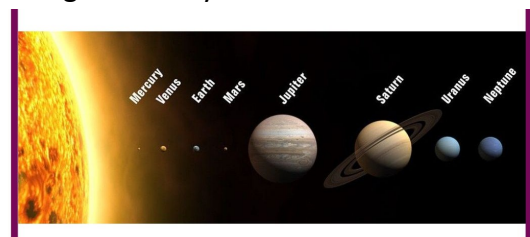


## K-1-2 - Kirralong Room
