Reading Groups and Mathematics are a big part of our days at school.

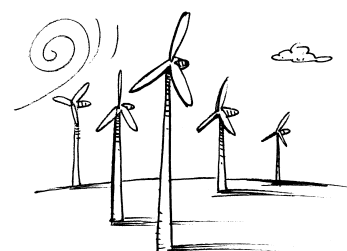
TARALGA WIND FARM COMMUNITY OPEN DAY

Hope many families would like to participate.

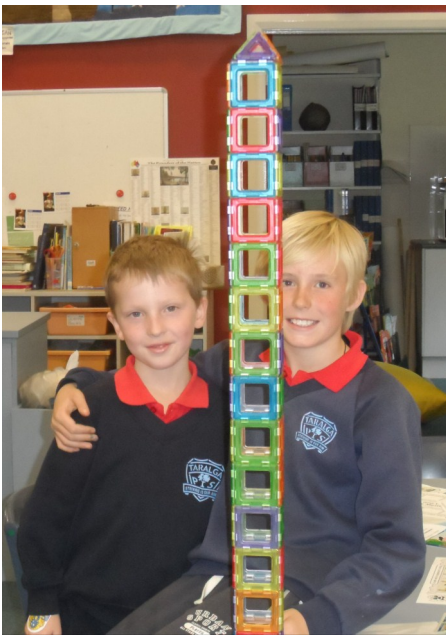
