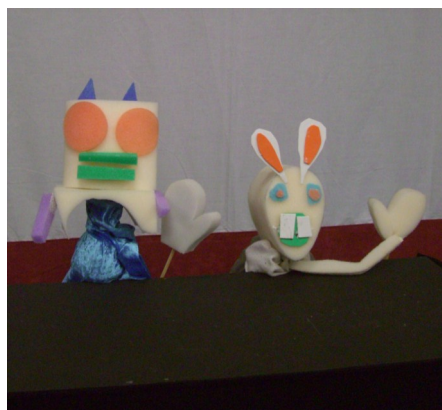
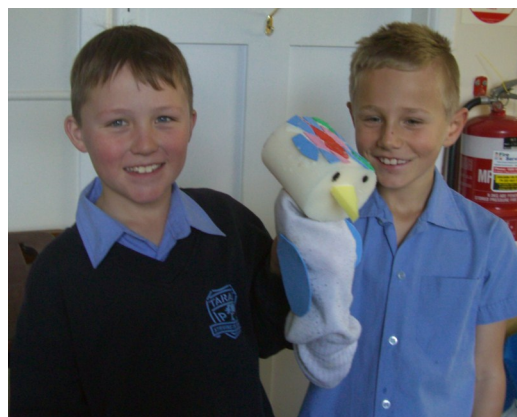
On Wednesday, 10th June, Ms Grahame attended a Road Safety Course. Ms Duncan and Sheridan were on class.
