We are asking that you, the parents, grandparents, etc., etc., support our markets so that we can continue to support this great school.

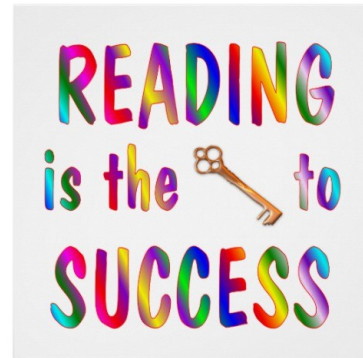

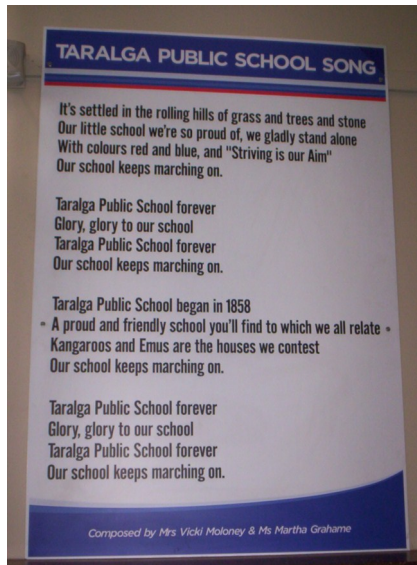
