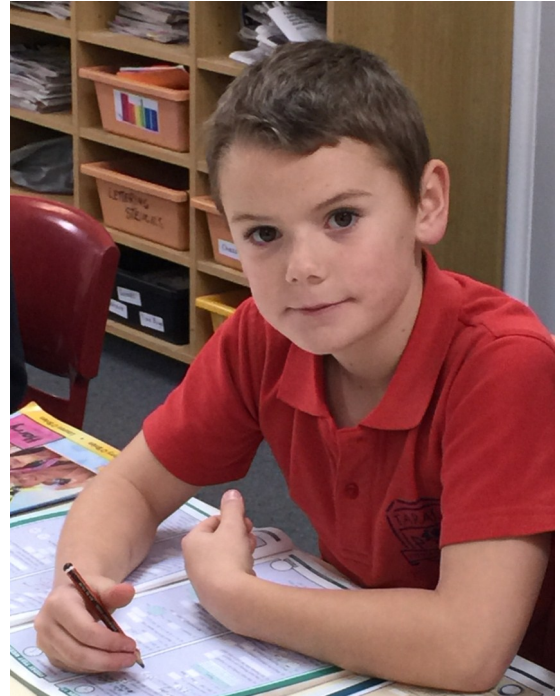
### THE OFFICE CORNER:
