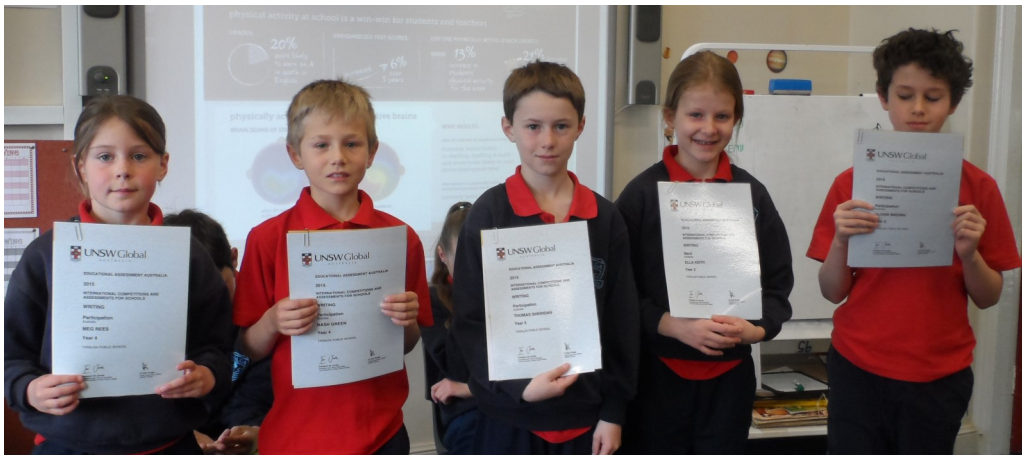

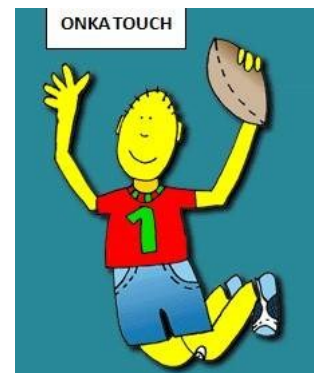
TOUCH FOOTBALL REGISTRATIONS

THE OFFICE CORNER:

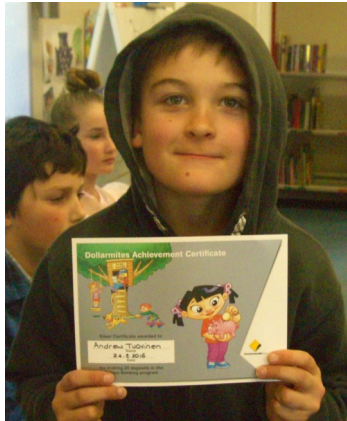
