Students had a great day at Milo Cricket on Monday, 21st March. Thanks to our P & C for paying for the cost of the bus.

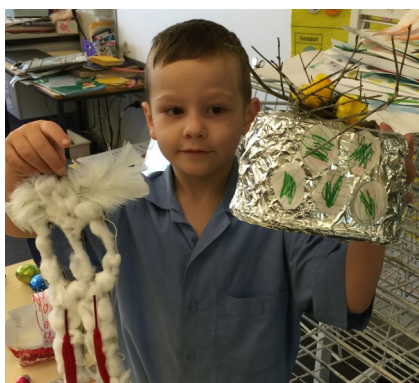
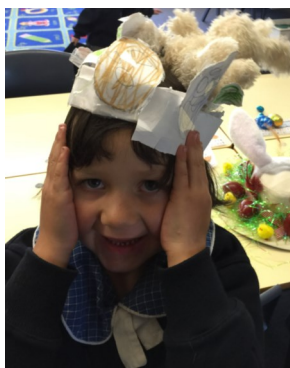
Thank you to the parents who attended our information session last Friday. After consultation with you, Mrs Natalie Kerr will join us for 4 days per week commencing Term 2.
