We hope the Mums loved their present and were spoiled on Mother's Day. Thanks again to the P & C.

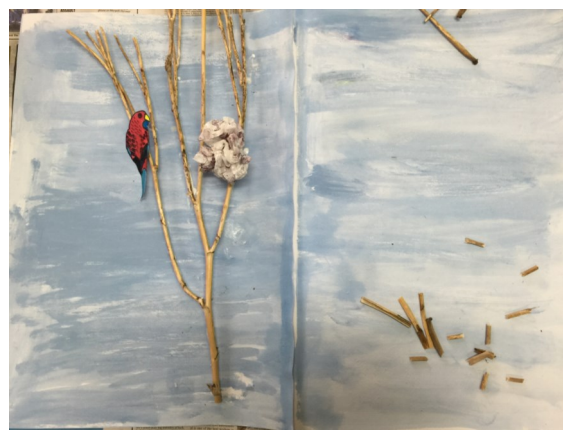
