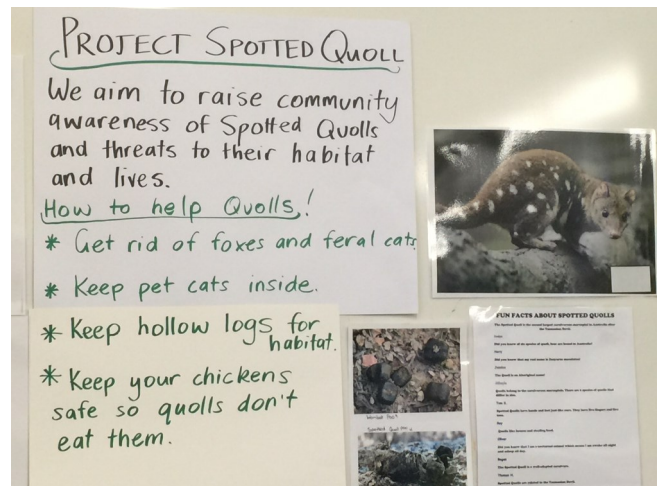

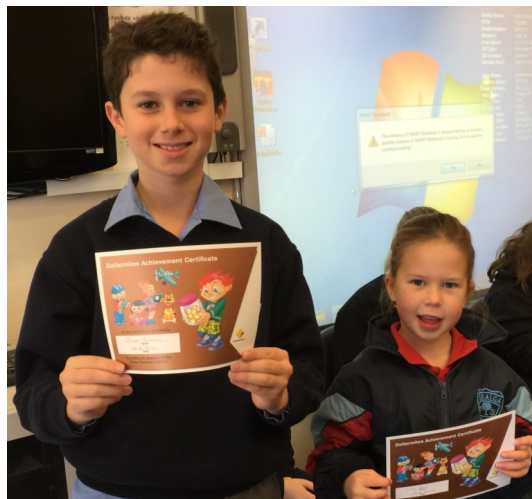
Please remember to bring your homework and reader bag back every Friday. It is important to try to do some reading every night. Practising reading helps you improve.
