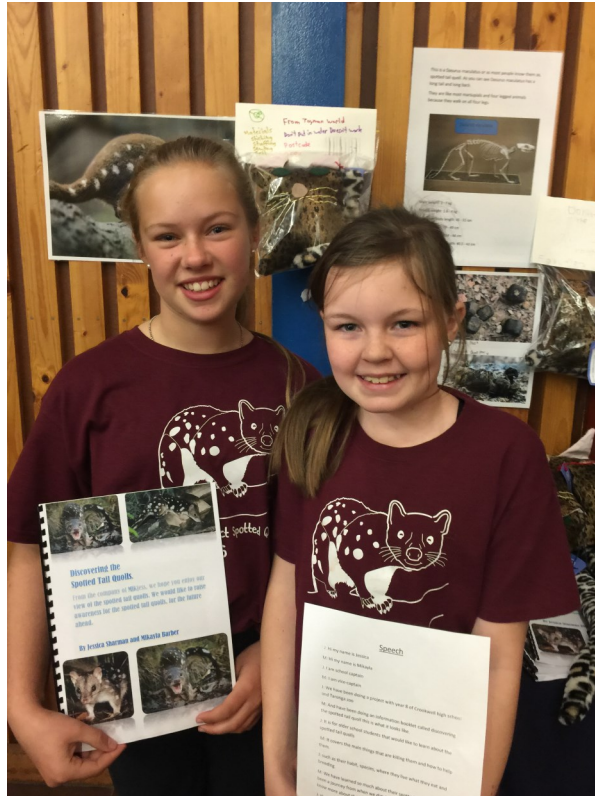

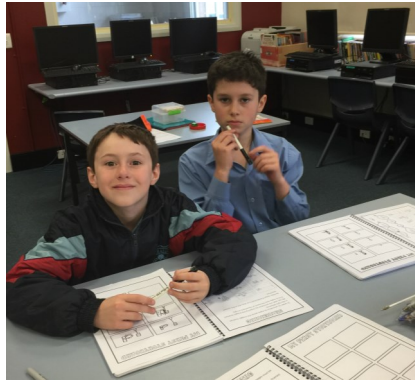
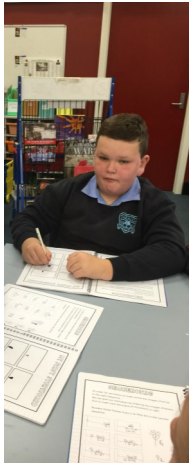
THE OFFICE CORNER:
