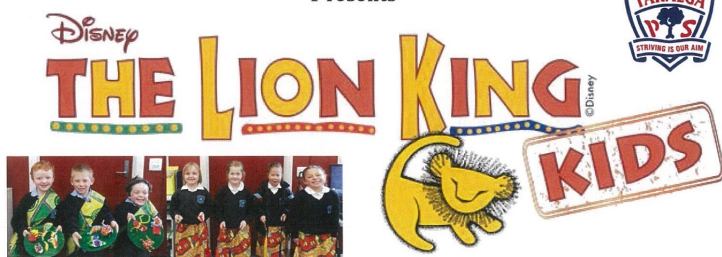

THE OFFICE CORNER:

MAKE ONLINE PAYMENTS:

It is now possible for parents to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card, and can be made via computer, table or mobile phone. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website by selecting - \$ Make a payment.

Items that can be paid for include - excursions; sales to students; band; drama or dance. There is also a category called "Other" this is to cover items not covered in the previous headings.

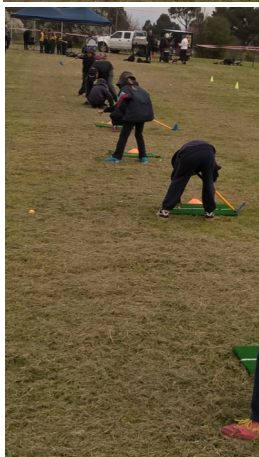
As we don't usually invoice students separately, payments may be made for the family by putting, eg:- Simpson family in the students name & DOB of one student. (For swimming etc).
