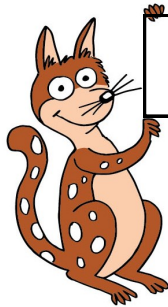

The Trivia Night is a major fundraiser for the P & C and we're hoping, with your support, to make it another successful

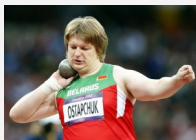

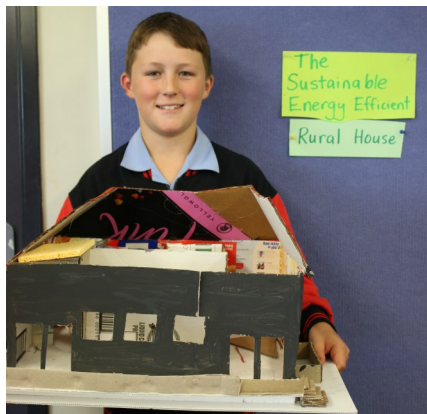
