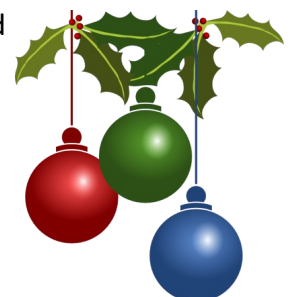


### 3-4-5-6 CURROUNG CLASSROOM
