The STEM ShowCASE was a great day for Years 3,4,5 & 6 to show off their projects. Special awards were given to Hannah and Lulu.

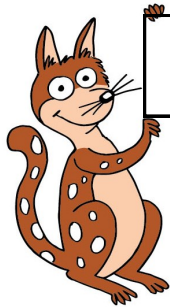
