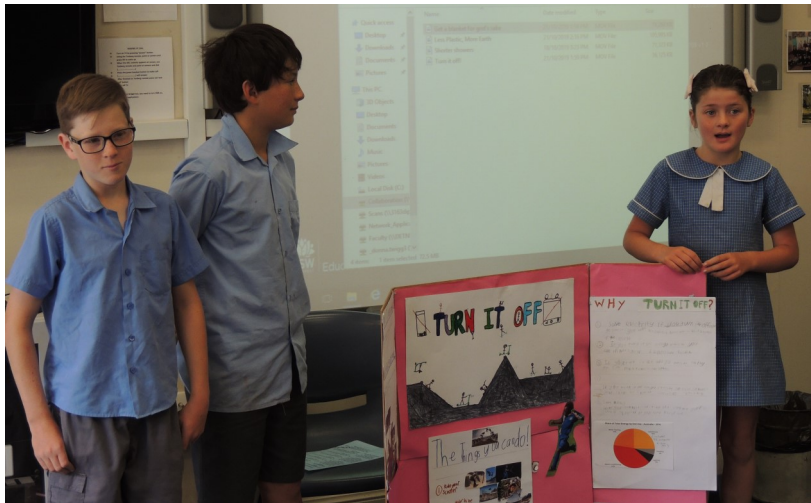




WALL OF FAME

THE OFFICE CORNER: FORWARD PLANNING - PRICE REDUCTIONS

Our students will be going on an excursion to Canberra on Thursday, 12th December - Questacon - \$7.50 (lucky for us, there is a 50% discount for December) and the Canberra Zoo - \$15.00 for each child. Therefore - \$22.50 per child. Our very generous P & C will pay for the bus.
