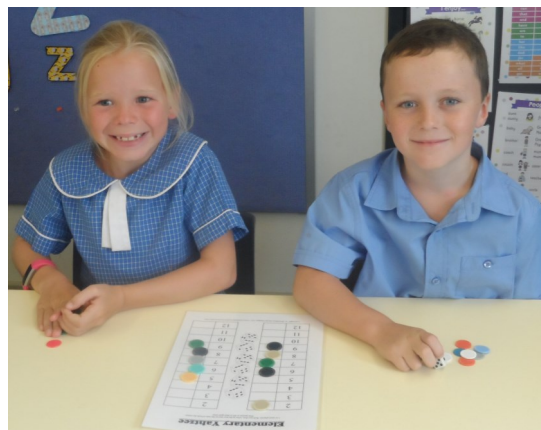


K-1-2 KIRRALONG CLASSROOM

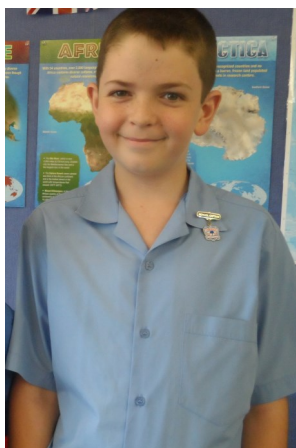


Congratulations to Tom Sheridan - he has received his 6th Certificate of Commendation - 18 Honour Ribbons & 180 Progress Awards.
