FORWARD NOTICE OF YEARS 5-6 CAMP - BERRY, NSW

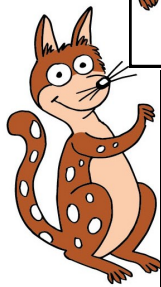
