WALL OF FAME

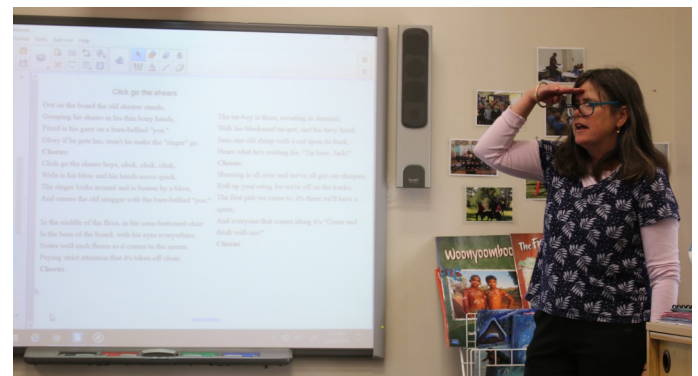
Congratulations to Regan Martin for achieving his 7th Certificate of Commendation—21 Honour Ribbons and 210 Progress Awards.
