Welcome back to Term 3. It is great to see everyone's smiling face back at school. We are looking forward to having a productive Term.


The children have finally finished creating their bird feeders and we will soon be hanging them around the school to see what birds we can attract to our playground.

Don't forget, Year 2 have tennis tomorrow so they will need their racquet.






Jeans for Genes®
