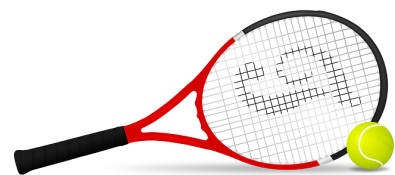


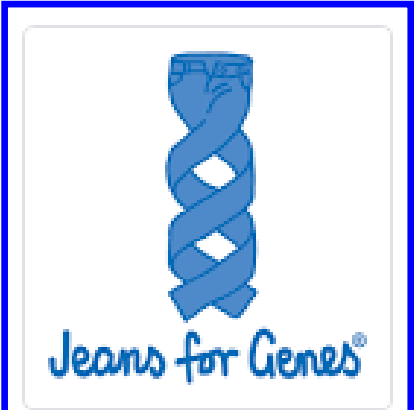
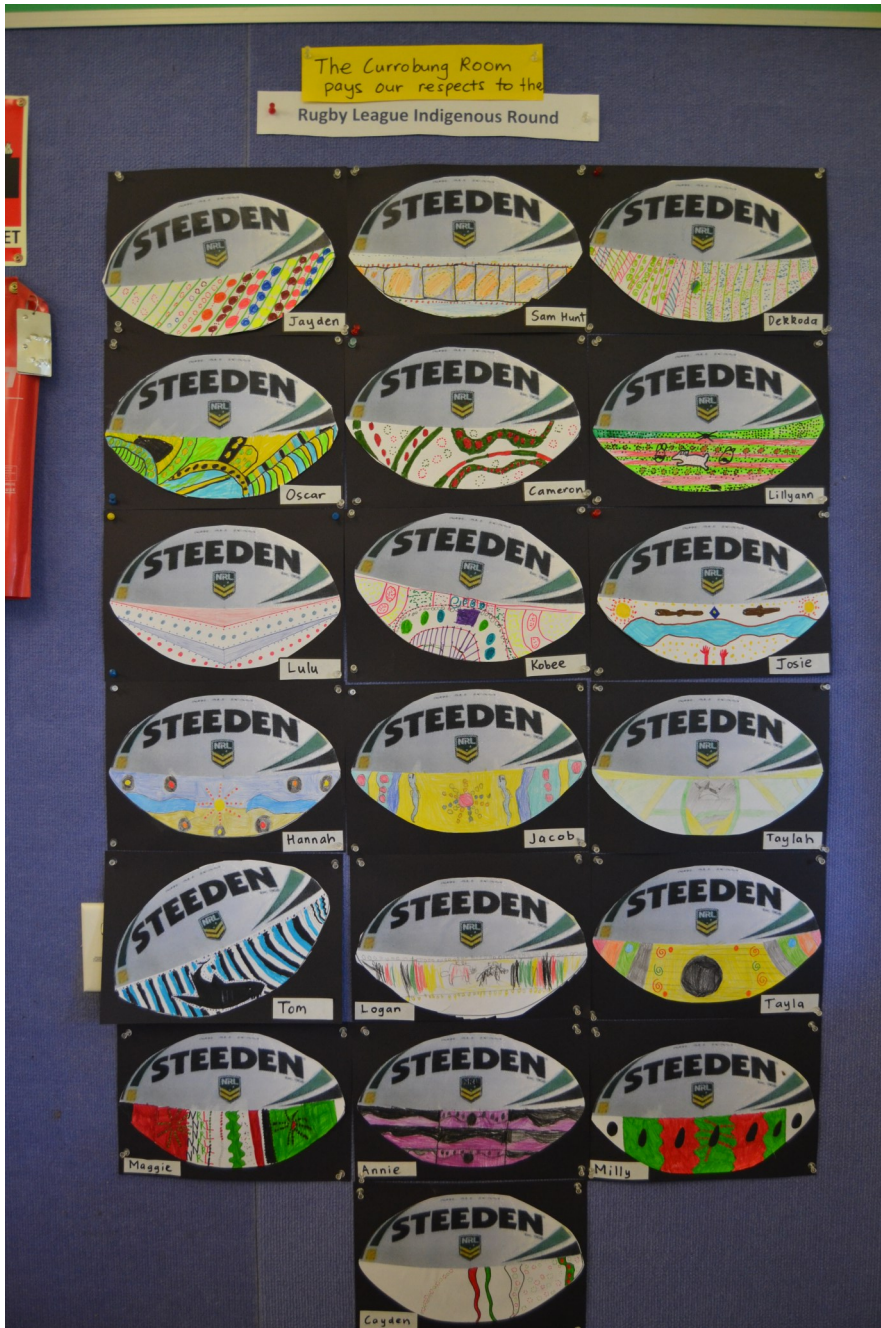
3-4-5-6 CURROBUNG CLASS ROOM

The students of the Currobung room have enjoyed supporting the NRL Indigenous Round by designing their own footballs as a tribute to Indigenous players and their heritage.

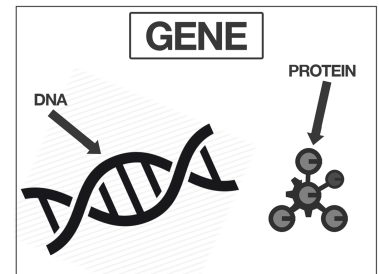
Tennis is on again on Fridays, weather permitting. Please wear your sports uniform and bring your racquet if possible.
